Meet the Central Kentucky Region, Model A Restorers Club

The Model A Restorers Club (MARC), founded in 1952, is a non-profit organization dedicated to the preservation and restoration of the Model A Ford as built by the Ford Motor Company from 1928 to 1931. It has members all over the world.

MARC's Central Kentucky Region (CKMARC), based in Lexington, was formed in 1986 and now has more than 50 member families. Its members live as far as 65 miles away.

What does CKMARC do?

CKMARC members use their Model A's as Henry Ford intended—we *drive* them!

Most of CKMARC's monthly activities are driving events, including two overnight trips per year. In winter, we offer indoor activities such as technical seminars, films, potluck dinners, and swap meets.

Traveling by Model A Ford is a great way to see the countryside, meet nice people, form lasting friendships, and escape from the pressures of modern life.

What? No car shows?

That's right. While MARC members generally restore their cars to some degree of authenticity, the local club's emphasis is on driving rather than shows. Its members, however, often participate in shows sponsored by other area clubs. In addition, MARC offers fine-point judging at its national meets.

You can't really drive a Model A any distance, can you?

Of course we can! Our one-day trips are 25 to 100 miles; our overnight trips may cover 250 miles—all on non-Interstate roads.



In recent years, member families have driven their Model A's to MARC National Meets in Indiana, Illinois, New York, North Carolina, Virginia, Wisconsin, Pennsylvania, Florida...and the Pacific Northwest!

On the trip to New York, two local Model A's took a detour, returning by way of Nova Scotia and New England—for a total distance of more than 4,000 miles. And two of our member families drove their Model A's on a 6,000-mile round trip to the 1994 meet in Tacoma, Washington!

Don't tell us you can't drive 'em!

What if you have trouble on the road?

The Model A is known for rugged dependability. But if a breakdown does occur, you're traveling with others, so help is available.

Do I have to own a Model A to join CKMARC?

Absolutely not! In fact, there are distinct advantages to joining *before* you acquire a Model A.

Once acquainted with other Model A owners, you're plugged into a network that can provide valuable leads and advice. Your club friends can guide you through the process of finding the Model A that's right for you—at a fair price.

Where on earth do you find parts?

That's a common question—almost as common as "Where's the car show?" when we're out driving.

Model A parts are readily available, both new and used. And that's another benefit of membership in CKMARC: the informal network helps put you in touch with parts and services.

Isn't it an expensive hobby?

Not necessarily. While other antique cars can cost a fortune to restore, the Model A is relatively inexpensive to buy and refurbish—especially if you do some or all of the work yourself. Because Henry designed the Model A with simplicity in mind, even the novice can restore one. Determination is the key.

How do I join?

All members of CKMARC must belong to the national Model A Restorers Club.

Family membership in the local region, at \$20.00 per year, includes a subscription to the monthly newsletter, *Checkmark*, which keeps members in touch with all local activities.

Your national membership includes six issues of *The Model A News*, a high quality magazine with articles on restoration and activities, as well as classified ads offering cars, parts, and services. National dues are \$40.00 per year.
