Terry Eugene Meek, 72, of Richmond, passed away Wednesday, August 23, 2017 at the VA Medical Center in Lexington.

Born July 2, 1945, in Lafayette, Indiana, he was the son of Bryan Floyd and Edith Josephine Bell Meek, both of whom preceded him in death. Terry was retired from the U.S. Air Force and was a veteran of the Vietnam War where he had served as a crew chief. Terry was also the owner and operator of Meek Print Shop.
